

for the sake of Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.

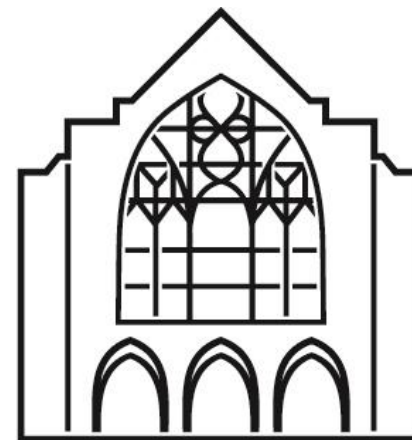
